a) Approve, ratify, and authorize the Chair to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Santa Barbara Neighborhood Clinics (SBNC), a California not-for-profit public benefit corporation to accept and receive reimbursement funding from SBNC for Preventing and Responding to Associated Health Conditions and Toxic Stress in Clinics through Community Engagement (ACEs PRACTICE) grant activities for the project period of September 1, 2022 through November 30, 2023, in the amount of \$50,000.00; and
