Title: Consider recommendations regarding amendments to increase contracts for Alcohol and Drug Program Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) services for FY 2008-09, as follows:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an Amendment to the contract with Aegis Medical Systems, Inc. (not a local vendor) to increase the contract by \$425,000, for a new contract maximum of \$1,325,000 for the period of July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009;
- b) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an Amendment to the contract with Good Samaritan Shelter, Inc. (a local vendor) to increase the contract by \$78,000, for a new contract maximum of \$328,000 for the period of July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009; and
- c) Authorize the Director of ADMHS to approve amendments to the proposed contracts, provided that any such amendments do not exceed ten percent (10%) of each contract's dollar amount.
