Title: Consider recommendations regarding early Psychosis Intervention Plus Program with the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) Fiscal Years (FYs) 2020-2025 Agreement Termination, as follows:

- a) Approve and authorize the Director of the Department of Behavioral Wellness or designee to terminate the multi-year grant agreement (No. 19MHSOAC089) with the MHSOAC for the Early Psychosis Intervention Plus Program for youth in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 for a four-year period from the date of execution of the agreement, March 9, 2021 through February 28, 2025;
- b) Direct the Director of the Department of Behavioral Wellness or designee to issue a letter, terminating the grant agreement, effective September 30, 2022; and
- c) Determine that the above actions are government fiscal activities or funding mechanisms which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment, and are therefore not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15378(b)(4) of the CEQA Guidelines.
