b) Authorize the Director of Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Services to approve amendments to the proposed contracts, providing that any such amendments or modifications do not exceed ten percent (10%) of the original total contact value;

c) Approve and execute an amendment to the existing NNA service agreement with the Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (a local vendor) increasing the provisional funding by \$87,500, for a new total contract amount of \$685,400.
