a) Receive and file a report on Emergency Permit 18EMP-00000-00003, which authorized the inspection, excavation and repair of twelve segments on four different high pressure natural gas pipelines;

b) Determine that issuance of the emergency permit is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant CEQA Guidelines section 15269(c), as this action was necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency; and

c) Determine that receiving and filing the report is not a project pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15378(b)(5), as it is an administrative government activity that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.
