**Title:** Acting as the Board of Directors, Laguna County Sanitation District:

Consider recommendations regarding the purchase of filtration membranes at the Laguna County Sanitation District Wastewater Reclamation Plant, Third District, as follows:

a) Authorize the County Purchasing Agent to procure membranes from GE Water and Process Technologies (parent company of Zenon), not a local vendor, without being required to conduct a formal bid process through June 30, 2018; and

b) Find that the proposed action is for the minor alteration of existing public facilities involving no expansion of the use beyond that which presently exists, that the proposed action is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to 14CCR 15301 and approve the

filing of a Notice of Exemption on that basis.
