Title: Consider recommendations regarding a Request for Waiver on Competition in Purchase of Huber Technologies, Inc. Maintenance Parts and Services for Laguna County Sanitation District, Fourth and Fifth Districts, as follows:

Acting as the Board of Directors, Laguna County Sanitation District:

- a) Authorize the County Purchasing Agent to waive competitive bidding requirements per County Code Section 2-39(c) to procure maintenance services and replacement parts from Huber Technology, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 annually, without being required to conduct a formal bid process through June 30, 2028; and
- b) Determine that the above action is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15378(b)(2) of the CEQA Guidelines, because it is for continuing maintenance activities for the purchase of supplies and maintenance services.
