- b) Find, in accordance with Government Code Section 31000, that the County does not have employee resources to complete the custodial work currently being completed by Big Green Cleaning Company and that the County's economic interests are served by the Agreement; and
- c) Determine that the recommended actions are not a "Project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and is exempt per CEQA Guideline section 15378(b)(5), since the recommended actions are organizational or administrative activities of the government that will not result in direct or indirect physical change in the environment.
