- b) Direct Community Services Department staff to file the Report with the Clerk of the Board;
- c) Direct the Clerk to publish notice beginning on June 23, 2021, in accord with California Government Code section 6066, of the hearing to be held on July 13, 2021 to consider the adoption of a Resolution that confirms the Report and that adjusts the FY 2021-2022 library special tax rate in CSA No. 3 by 1.6%, which reflects the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for 2020 (the Resolution); and
- d) Set a hearing on July 13, 2021 to consider the adoption of the Resolution, as follows:
(Set a hearing for July 13, 2021. Time estimate: 10 minutes)
- i) Adopt a Resolution that confirms the Report and adjusts the FY 2021-2022 library special tax rate in CSA No. 3 by 1.6%; and
- ii) Determine that the above recommended actions are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guideline Sections 15378(b)(4) and 15378(b)(5) because the actions consist of organizational or administrative actions that will have no direct physical impact on the environment and the creation of government funding mechanisms or other government fiscal activities which do not involve any commitment to any specific project.
