b) Determine that the recommended action is not a "Project" that is subject to environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378 (b)(5), because it is an organizational or administrative activity of the government that will not result in

direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.
