\$636,705.00 for FY 2024-2025);

b) Authorize the Public Works Director or his/her designee to approve changes or additions to the work and goods for a 10% contingency amount of up to \$178,788.00 for a total not-to-exceed contract

amount of \$1,966,666.00; and

c) Determine that the proposed contract does not constitute a "Project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), pursuant to 14 CCR 15378 (b)(5) (administrative activity

of government).
