c) Authorize the General Services Department to purchase a truck and related equipment in the amount of \$39,000.00 for the Public Health Department's Hazardous Materials program; and

d) Determine that these activities are exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review per CEQA Guideline Section 15378(b)(4), since the recommended actions are government fiscal activities which do not involve commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment.
