Consider recommendations regarding an agreement for Secure Continuous Remote Alcohol Monitoring (SCRAM) of California services, as follows:

- a) Approve, ratify, and authorize the Chair to execute the Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor with SCRAM of California to provide SCRAM services that includes equipment, installation, and removal of equipment, monitoring, training, and support for adult clients, who are under supervision by the Probation Department, including pre-trial defendants released to the Pre-Trial Supervision program, with a revised total contract amount not to exceed \$448,000.00, inclusive of \$155,000.00 under Purchase Contract CN24954, but which otherwise cancels, nullifies, and supersedes Purchase Contract CN24954 from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022;
- b) Authorize the Chief Probation Officer or designee to approve subsequent line-item budget changes to the Agreement in an amount not to exceed 10% of the stated line-item budgeted amounts for the service, as long as the total contract amount of the Agreement is not increased, and as long as the total budgeted amounts by each funding source are not exceeded; and
- c) Determine that the above actions are government fiscal activities of funding mechanisms which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment, and are therefore not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15378(b)(4) of the CEQA guidelines.
