- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a First Amendment to the Agreement with the City of Buellton to provide animal control services for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$31,469.00;
- b) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an Agreement with the City of Goleta to provide animal control services for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$207,572.00;
- c) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a First Amendment to the Agreement with the City of Guadalupe to provide animal control services for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$43,152.00;
- d) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a First Amendment to the Agreement with the City of Lompoc to provide animal control services for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$254,842.00;
- e) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a First Amendment to the Agreement with the City of Santa Barbara to provide animal sheltering services for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$288,121.00;
- f) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a First Amendment to the Agreement with the City of Santa Maria to provide animal control services for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$544,772.00;
- g) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a First Amendment to the Agreement with the City of Solvang to provide animal control services for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$36,648.00;
- h) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a First Amendment to the Agreement with the Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians to provide animal control services for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 in the amount of \$1,703.00;
- i) Determine that these activities are exempt from California Environmental Quality Act review per CEQA Guideline Section 15061(b)(3), since it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activities may have a significant effect on the environment.
