Title:	HEARING - Consider recommendations regarding the County and Montecito Planning Commissions recommendations to adopt three Ordinances, Case Nos. 19ORD-00000-00003, 19ORD-00000-00004, and 19ORD-00000-00005, which would amend, respectively, the County Land Use and Development Code (CLUDC), the Montecito Land Use and Development Code (MLUDC), and the Coastal Zoning Ordinance (Article II), to implement a series of amendments that revise procedures and regulations for commercial telecommunications facilities and recordable documents to implement federal and state regulations; delete repealed and expired regulations; delete uncertified regulations from the CLUDC and MLUDC that were intended to apply solely within the Coastal Zone; and make other minor clarifications, corrections, and revisions; and in addition, consider recommendations regarding submittal of the Article II amendments to the California Coastal Commission (Coastal Commission) for certification as amendments to the Santa Barbara County Local Coastal Program (LCP), as follows: (EST.
