- c) Consider recommendations regarding Case No. 16ORD-00000-00016 (Article II Coastal Zoning Ordinance Amendment), as follows:
- i) Make the findings for approval, including CEQA findings, of the proposed Ordinance;
- ii) Determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to Sections 15282(h) and 15265 of the Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA; and
- iii) Adopt an Ordinance (Case No. 16ORD-00000-00016) amending Article II, the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code.
