**Title:** Consider recommendations regarding Contractor on Payroll (COP) Agreements for Fiscal Year 2014-2015, as follows:

- a) Approve and authorize a Contractor on Payroll Agreement with George Bajor, M.D., for the period of July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015 to provide psychiatric services in an amount not to exceed \$71,700.00;
- b) Approve and authorize a Contractor on Payroll Agreement with Harold Ginsberg, M.D., for the period of July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015 to provide psychiatric services in an amount not to exceed \$114,400.00;
- c) Approve and authorize a Contractor on Payroll Agreement with Daniel Litten, M.D., for the period of July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015 to provide psychiatric services in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00;
- d) Approve and authorize a Contractor on Payroll Agreement with Irwin Lunianski, M.D., for the period of July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015 to provide psychiatric services in an amount not to exceed \$105,600.00; and
- e) Determine that the above actions are government fiscal activities or funding mechanisms which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment, and are therefore not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15378(b)(4) of the CEQA guidelines.
