e) Adopt the Mitigation and Monitoring Programs attached to the addenda for individual projects described in Section 2 of the Fiscal Year 2006/07 Annual Maintenance Plan; and

f) Approve individual projects described in Section 2 of the Fiscal Year 2006/07 Annual Plan.
