	d) Receive and file a presentation from California Seismic Safety Commission officials on the Commission's work to assist local governments in reducing earthquake losses, increasing resiliency and enhancing recovery; and		
	e) Determine that the above actions are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15262 and approve the filing of a Notice of Exemption.
