Title:	<p>Consider recommendations regarding Milhous Children Services Inc. DBA Mountain Valley Child and Family Services, Fiscal Year (FY) 2014-2017 First Amendment and FY 2017-2019 Contract Renewal, as follows:</p> <p>a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a First Amendment to the Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor Milhous Children Services DBA Mountain Valley Child and Family Services (not a local vendor), for the provision of children's residential services, to clarify billing processes and to increase the contract by \$65,000.00 for FY 2016-2017 due to unanticipated additional services provided, for a new total for FY 2016-2017 of \$175,000.00 and a new multiyear contract total amount of \$395,000.00 through June 30, 2017;</p> <p>b) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an Agreement for Services of Independent Contractor with Mountain Valley Child and Family Services Inc. (not a local vendor), for the provision of children's residential services, for a maximum contract amount not to exceed \$110,000.00 for FY 2017-2018 and \$55,000.00 for FY 2018-2019, for a multiyear total contract amount not to exceed \$165,000.00 for FY 2017-2019 during the period July 1, 2017 through December 31, 2018; and</p> <p>c) Determine that the above actions are government fiscal activities or funding mechanisms which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in potentially physical impact on the environment, and are therefore not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15378(b)(4) of the CEQA guidelines.</p>
