b) Find that the proposed action is required to protect public health and the environment as required by County Public Health Department, Environmental Health Services, the Local Enforcement Agency for CalRecycle, consist of construction of small structures and minor alteration of the land and is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to 14 CCR Sections 15306 (Information Collection), 15308 (Actions by Regulatory Agencies for the Protection of the

Environment), Section 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) and 15304 (Minor

Alterations to Land), and approve the filing of a Notice of Exemption on that basis.
