Title:	Consider recommendations regarding Local Vendors-County Wide Contracts for Temporary Staffing for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 and Fiscal Year 2018-2019, as follows: a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Agreements for Services of Independent Contractor to provide temporary employment services for the period of June 19, 2018 through June 30, 2019 in an amount not to exceed \$175,000.00 for the duration of the contract, with each of the following local vendors: i) Crossroads Staffing; and ii) Robert Half International Inc.
