b) Approve Budget Revision Request No. 0006091 to establish appropriations of \$780,000.00 for services and supplies funded by Committed Disaster Recovery Fund Balance; and

c) Determine that the proposed actions are administrative activities that do not involve commitment to any specific project, and are therefore not a project as defined by State California Environmental

Quality Act Guidelines Sections 15378 (b)(5).
