	b) Award, and authorize the Chair to execute an Energy Service Contract with Endelos Energy (a local vendor) in the amount of \$4,336,751.00 for final design, construction and startup of renewable energy systems, energy conservation measures, and equipment upgrades at the Betteravia Campus (Santa Maria);				
	c) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an On-Bill Financing Loan Agreement, in a form substantially similar to the sample agreement, for an On Bill 0% Financing Loan from PG&E in the amount of \$614,221.00 with a 10-year term to fund the energy efficient lighting upgrades;				
	d) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a loan agreement and promissory note, in a form substantially similar to the agreement and note, and related documents for an Energy Efficiency 1% interest loan with a 15-year term from the California Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission for the Betteravia Campus renewable energy project in the amount of \$2,122,530.00; and				
	e) Determine that the renewable energy project is statutorily exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to California Public Resources Code Section 21080.35 (installing solar systems on existing roofs and existing parking lots), and that it is further categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA per Sections 15301 (minor alterations to existing facilities) and 15303 (limited construction of small facilities) and 15304 (minor alterations to land) of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations and direct staff to file a Notice of Exemption on that basis.

b) Award, and authorize the Chair to execute an Energy Service Contract with Endelos Energy (a local vendor) in the amount of \$4,336,751.00 for final design, construction and startup of renewable energy systems, energy conservation measures, and equipment upgrades at the Betteravia Campus (Santa Maria);

c) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute an On-Bill Financing Loan Agreement, in a form substantially similar to the sample agreement, for an On Bill 0% Financing Loan from PG&E in the amount of \$614,221.00 with a 10-year term to fund the energy efficient lighting upgrades;

d) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute a loan agreement and promissory note, in a form substantially similar to the agreement and note, and related documents for an Energy Efficiency 1% interest loan with a 15-year term from the California Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission for the Betteravia Campus renewable energy project in the amount of \$2,122,530.00; and

e) Determine that the renewable energy project is statutorily exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to California Public Resources Code Section 21080.35 (installing solar systems on existing roofs and existing parking lots), and that it is further categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA per Sections 15301 (minor alterations to existing facilities) and 15303 (limited construction of small facilities) and 15304 (minor alterations to land) of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations and direct staff to file a Notice of Exemption on that basis.
