c) Approve Budget Revision Request No. 0006978 establishing appropriations in the Sheriff's General Fund of \$20,000.00 for the D.A.R.E. program and \$8,580.00 for the Sheriff's Custody Operations K-9; and

d) Find that the proposed action does not constitute a "project" under the California Environmental Quality Act because it is within the exception provided by 14 CCR 15378(b)(4) for "[t]he creation of government funding mechanisms or other government fiscal activities, which do not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment."
