- b) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the License Agreement with Explore Ecology for the use and management of the approximately 1,470 square foot SCWRC at 2981 ½ Cliff Drive, Santa Barbara, CA 93109, a portion of County Assessor Parcel No. 047-092-013, for a term of five (5) years plus one option to extend for a period of one (1) additional year;
- c) Authorize the General Services Director, or designee, to approve a one-year extension of the initial five-year term as set forth more fully in Section 7 of the License Agreement; and
- d) Determine that the recommended actions are exempt from environmental review in accordance with California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15301, Existing Facilities, and Section 15323, Normal Operation of Facilities for Public Gatherings, and direct staff to file a Notice of Exemption on that basis.
