**Title:** Consider recommendations regarding re-ratification of a Proclamation of Local Emergency Caused by

Drought Conditions, Last Action July 13, 2021, (Sixty-Day Renewal), as follows:

b) Direct the Office of Emergency Management to return every sixty (60) days for re-ratification of the Emergency until such a time that weather and water supply conditions dictate otherwise; and

c) Determine that these actions are exempt from the provisions of California Environmental Quality

Act (CEQA) pursuant CEQA Guidelines Sections 15061(b)(3) and 15269(a).
