by the Flood Control District; and

b) Find that the Cooperative Stream Gauging Program is exempt under California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15306, basic data collection, research, experimental management, and

resources evaluation activities; and approve the filing of a Notice of Exemption on that basis.
