a) Authorize the County Purchasing Agent to waive competitive bidding requirements per County Code Section 2-39(c) to procure wastewater treatment process chemicals from Brenntag Pacific, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.00 annually; and Garratt-Callahan Company in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 annually, without being required to conduct a formal bid process through June 20,000.00 annually, without being required to conduct a formal bid process through June

b) Determine that the above action is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15378(b)(2) of the CEQA Guidelines, because it is for continuing
