Consider recommendations regarding the adoption of Government Code Section 31646(c), as follows:

a) Adopt a Resolution making the provisions of Government Code Section 31646(c) applicable to the County, which would allow Santa Barbara County Employee Retirement System (SBCERS) members to purchase retirement service credit for an unpaid leave due to the serious illness of a family member when the absence is eligible for coverage under the federal Family and Medical Leave Act (FMLA) or the California Family Rights Act (CFRA); and

b) Determine pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5) that the above action is an organizational or administrative activity of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.
