HEARING - Consider recommendations regarding the Impact Report on County Facilities Maintenance Ordinance Initiative Petition, as follows: (EST. TIME: 45 MIN.)

- a) Receive and file the "Impact Report on County Facilities Maintenance Ordinance Petition" memorandum, and either:
- i) Adopt the Ordinance without alteration within 10 days; or
- ii) Order the proposed Ordinance to be submitted without alteration to the voters of the County at the June 3, 2014 Statewide Direct Primary Election by adopting a Resolution which includes direction to Auditor Controller to prepare a fiscal impact statement;
- b) If the Board orders the proposed Ordinance be submitted to the voters, consider appointing member(s) of the Board of Supervisors to author, sign and submit on behalf of the Board a direct argument in favor and/or against the County Facilities Maintenance Ordinance ballot measure and any rebuttal; and
- c) Determine that the proposed action is a submittal of a proposal to a vote of the people and not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15378(b)(3).
