HEARING - Consider the recommendations of the County and Montecito Planning Commissions to approve Case Nos. 15ORD-00000-00002, 15ORD-00000-00003 and 15ORD-00000-00004 which would amend, respectively, the County Land Use and Development Code (LUDC), the Montecito LUDC, and the Article II Coastal Zoning Ordinance, to implement a series of amendments that revise existing procedures and regulations, add new procedures and regulations, and correct and clarify existing language, as follows: (EST. - a) Consider recommendations regarding Case No. 15ORD-00000-00002 (County LUDC Amendment), as follows:
- i) Make the findings for approval, including California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) findings, of the proposed Ordinance;
- ii) Determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is categorically exempt from CEQA in compliance with Section 15061 (b)(3) of the Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA; and
- iii) Adopt an Ordinance (Case No. 15ORD-00000-00002) amending Section 35-1, the Santa Barbara County LUDC, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code;
- b) Consider recommendations regarding Case No. 15ORD-00000-00003 (Montecito LUDC Amendment), as follows:
- i) Make the findings for approval, including CEQA findings, of the proposed Ordinance;
- ii) Determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is categorically exempt from CEQA in compliance with Section 15061 (b)(3) of the Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA; and
- iii) Adopt an Ordinance (Case No. 15ORD-00000-00003) amending Section 35-2, the Santa Barbara County Montecito LUDC, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code; and
- c) Consider recommendations regarding Case No. 15ORD-00000-00004 (Article II Coastal Zoning Ordinance Amendment), as follows:
- i) Make the findings for approval, including CEQA findings, of the proposed Ordinance;
- ii) Determine that the adoption of this Ordinance is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Sections 15061(b)(3) and 15265 of the Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA; and
- iii) Adopt an Ordinance (15ORD-00000-0004) amending Article II, the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance, of Chapter 35, Zoning, of the County Code.
